apeel™ is a patented dual skin tension curtain system, which provides fleet operators with a non-obtrusive, quick-change tension curtain system that is cost effective and easy to replace without compromising aesthetics or operational requirements.



The system looks and operates like a traditional PVC tension curtain. Designed with focus on the demands of the transport industry, the apeel™ system utilises industry leading, high quality components that have been rigorously tested under operational conditions to ensure durability and ease of operation.

The system can be specified to meet your exact requirements and can be installed to most commercial vehicle bodies. No special tools or extensive training are required to operate the system or change the outer skin, making it quick and easy ensuring vehicles are back on the road within minimal downtime.

Once the full apeel™ system has been installed, only the outer skin needs replaced, the inner skin is the infrastructure of the system which stays on at all times. Removing the outer skin is a quick and simple process, made achievable by our high quality quick release components. Simply remove all the locator pins and remove the skin, then attach the new skin and replace the locator pins. Once installed, finally tighten the outer skin via the vehicle tension ratchets and firmly secure the buckles. The outer skin can be changed within 15 minutes and can be changed anywhere.



The quick change system offers fleet operators the ability to maximise the adaptability of vehicles as client branding can be changed in a matter of minutes thus allowing the same vehicle to be utilised on a variety of contracts. No longer are fleet operators restricted by the branding on particular vehicles.

apeel™ also allows fleet operators to offer vehicles to new and existing clients as a valuable marketing tool and help strengthen client relationships and as companies increasingly recognise the importance of vehicle branding, the ability to offer this service becomes paramount.

PROCESS



STEP 1

It's as simple to remove & fit a new outer skin



STEP 2

Locate the tension pole, attach the curtain at the top then sweep across the trailer attaching the quick release components, ensuring the end pole is securely fitted.



STEP 3

Once this is complete, the fitter simply feeds the straps through the durable metal eyelets before applying the buckle and through-pin.



STEP 4

To finalise, the curtain is tightened through the tension ratchet and then the buckles are firmly secured.



STEP 5

In less than 15 minutes, the outer skin can be replaced with no complex tooling required.



STEP 6

Removing the skin is a quick and simple process, simply detach the quick release components, and peel the outer skin off.
